

# Arkansas Rural Connect Application



This is the application for the Arkansas Rural Connect (ARC) Broadband Grant Program. The ARC program application includes four (4) sections:

1. A section for local officials – **completed in its entirety**
2. A section for Internet Service Providers (ISPs) – **completed in its entirety**
3. A multi-tab Excel spreadsheet that must be **completed in its entirety** by the ISP
4. A .kmz or .kml file showing the project footprint, fiber layout, and buffered zones for this area footprint

The application window for Arkansas Rural Connect funding will be determined by the Broadband Office. The dates will be posted on our website at: [broadband.arkansas.gov](http://broadband.arkansas.gov). Applications submitted after this deadline are not considered for funding.

**Note:** The ARC Rules document requires broadband internet availability at a minimum of 100Mbps Down/100 Mbps Up synchronous. The project deliverable expectations are: 97.5% uptime at 1% average availability always, including peak hours of 7 pm CT to 11 pm CT.

**Note:** Project Closure refers to the time period the ARC Rules and obligations will be enforced. This time period requires each ISP to operate, maintain, upgrade and service the network infrastructure that is awarded, constructed and implemented up and unto January 1, 2030. Failure to comply with this project closure may result in enforcement of **ARC Rules (Section 11: D-J)**.
